2. Registration

- The registration desk will be manned by the conference secretariat throughout both days of the event.
- Participants can choose to sign in and collect their conference kits on either day.
- The registration desk will commence operations at 8.15am on Day 1. On Day 2, it will open slightly later i.e. at 9.00am.
- The conference kit (including ID tags, certificates and proceedings CD-ROM) can only be collected if full payment has been made.
- Participants who have registered under the student category may be asked to show their original Student ID cards before collecting their conference kits.

3. Oral Presentation Sessions

- Papers in the same session will be presented in the sequence shown in the schedule without any breaks in between.
- Presenters will be given **20 minutes** to deliver their presentations. Out of this, at least **5 minutes** must be allocated for Q&A or discussion at the end of their presentations.
- Any swapping of slots, even if mutually agreed between presenters, must be approved by the secretariat.
- Session 4 (on Day 2) has been designated as a Malay Language session. Presentations in this session will be delivered in the Malay Language.

4. Poster Viewing and Q&A Session

- Posters must be submitted to the secretariat **before 9.00am** on the first day of the event.
- The poster viewing and Q&A session is between 3.00pm and 3.30pm on Day 1. During this period, presenters are required to be beside their respective posters to answer questions or receive comments from the audience.

5. Coffee Breaks and Lunch

- Refreshments will be served in near the conference hall during the break times shown in the schedule.
- Lunch will be served at the hotel restaurant. Participants are required to display their conference identification tags in order to be seated.

6. Session Chairs

Session chairs have been selected from among those who have volunteered during the online registration process.
